ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sankalp Institute of Education, 141, Duhai, District- Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.T.C. Course of two year duration on 30.12.2004.

2. AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the said Institution under section 15 was conducted by visiting team on 13.12.2005. The report of the visiting team was considered by NRC in its 99th Meeting held on December, 22-23, 2005 and NRC decided that Institution does not fulfill the requirement of NCTE Regulations and Norms & Standards prescribed by NCTE for B.T.C. Course, hence, notice be issued to the Institution. Accordingly, notice was issued to the Institution on 17.01.2006. The reply received in response to notice was considered by NRC in its 104th Meeting held on July, 15-17, 2005 and NRC decided to grant conditional recognition to the Institution for B.T.C. course with an annual intake of 50 students subject to appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University. Accordingly letter was issued on 26.07.2006 to the Institution.

3. AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution had not submitted any compliance, hence, the matter was placed before NRC in its 141st Meeting held on May, 22-24, 2009 and the Committee decided to refuse the recognition for B.T.C. Course. Accordingly, recognition was refused on 16.04.2010. The Institution, thereafter, preferred an appeal dated 14.05.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council vide order dated 19.07.2010 accepted the appeal, set aside NRC's order dated 16.04.2010 and remanded back to the case to NRC with the direction to allow a period of 3 months to the Institution for fulfilling the requirement regarding appointment of faculty.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the Committee in its 164th Meeting held on August, 28-29, 2010 and the Committee decided that a letter may be issued to the Institution to complete the process of appointment of faculty within 3 months as directed in the Appellate Authority order as per the selection procedure stipulated in the NCTE Regulations. Accordingly, letter was issued to the Institution on 21.09.2010. The reply dated 07.10.2010 of the Institution received in response to NRC letter dated 21.09.2010 giving 3 months time to appoint the faculty for the B.T.C. Course has been carefully considered by NRC in its 172nd Meeting held from November, 12-13, 2010 and it was decided that Show Cause Notice under section 15(3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the Institution before refusing the recognition. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued to the Institution on 19.11.2010. The reply of the Institution dated 13.12.2010 w.r.t. the Show Cause Notice was considered by NRC in its 175th Meeting held on December, 30-31, 2010 and it was decided to seek clarification from the Institution. Accordingly, clarification sought from the Institution vide letter 17.02.2011.

5. AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by the Institution was considered by NRC in its 182nd Meeting and as per decision taken by NRC, Show Cause Notice dated 27.06.2011 was issued to Institution. The reply submitted by the Institution was considered NRC in its 188th Meeting held from 11th November to 15th November, 2011 and NRC decided that recognition for D.El.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 50 seats be granted to the Institution under section 15(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2012-2013.

6. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Sankalp Institute of Education, 141, Duhai, District- Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting B.T.C. Course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty only) Students from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- The Institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated alongwith an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

7. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

8. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.
